An incident that happened to a friend during the lead-up to the 2010 election served as the seed that has grown in to the Patriots Business Alliance.

In August of 2010 a friend of mine was involved in an automobile accident. Fortunately, he wasn't hurt. Unfortunately, his vehicle was "nearly totaled".
